- Living between Paris and Madrid, born in 1961 in Segovia (Spain), Alberto Reguera studied at the University of Valladolid (degree in Modern History, 1985). He is often keen to collaborate with artists outside the pictorial world, for example with musician Baart Spaan or major contemporary poets such as Francisco Pino or Andrée Chédid.
